Park passes are obtained directly from the Kingsbury Water Park (KWP) reception and are subject to the KWP terms and conditions. All membership types are entitled to one KWP park pass. Family membership entitles the member to two KWP passes.

You must produce your membership card to obtain a new or replacement park pass.

- 6) Before racing I will inform the OD of any medical condition that I have which may occur whilst sailing or affect my ability to sail.
- 7) I agree to abide by all of the clubs polices which are available to view at the club house.

- 9) I acknowledge that watersport activities carry risks and will not hold the officers of the club liable for any injury or loss that may occur.

- 11) I acknowledge that I represent the club and will conduct myself in an appropriate manner at all times.
- 12) The club will not accept liability for any loss or damage of property belonging to members, their guests or visitors to the club.
- 13) Members agree that before inviting guests onto the premises that they will draw their attention to the above rules of the club.
- 14) I will not store any craft on the clubs premises until I have had confirmation that membership has been accepted and the Harbour master has allocated a berth.
